I will send you to Jesse the Bethlehemite, for I have provided for myself a king among his sons." ⁶ When they came, he looked on Eliab and thought, "Surely the LORD's anointed is before him." 7 But the Lord said to Samuel, "Do not look on his appearance or on the height of his stature, because I have rejected him. For the LORD sees not as man sees: man looks on the outward appearance, but the LORD looks on the heart." ¹⁰ And Jesse made seven of his sons pass before Samuel.
