#### OLD GESTADENT READING

1 Samuel 3:1-10, 19

And the word of the LORD was precious in those days; there was no open vision. <sup>2</sup> And it came to pass at that time, when Eli was laid down in his place, and his eyes began to wax dim, that he could not see; <sup>3</sup> And ere the lamp of God went out in the temple of

the LORD, where the ark of God was, and Samuel was laid down to sleep; <sup>4</sup> That the LORD called Samuel: and he answered, Here am I. <sup>5</sup> And he ran unto Eli, and said, Here am I; for thou calledst me. And he said, I called not; lie down again. And he went and lay down. <sup>6</sup> And the LORD called yet again, Samuel. And Samuel arose and went to Eli, and said, Here am I; for thou didst call me. And he answered, I called not, my son; lie down again. <sup>7</sup> Now Samuel did not yet know the LORD, neither was the word of the LORD yet revealed unto him. <sup>8</sup> And the LORD called Samuel again the third time. 
HOLU GOSPEL John 1:43-51
