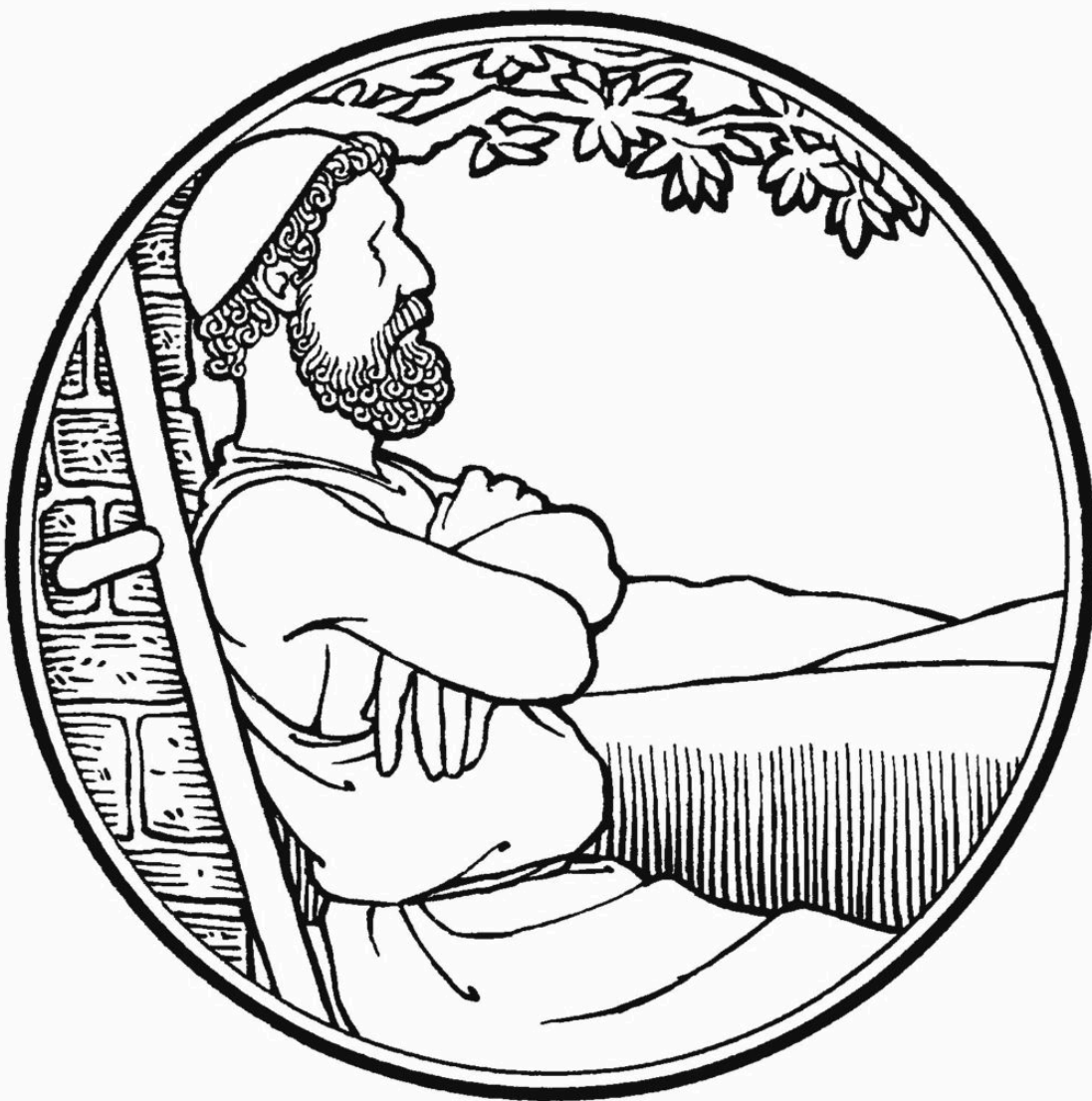

### OLD TESTAMENT READING

1 Samuel 3:1-10, 19

**A**ND THE CHILD Samuel ministered unto the LORD before Eli. And the word of the LORD was precious in those days; there was no open vision. <sup>2</sup> And it came to pass at that time, when Eli was laid down in his place, and his eyes began to wax dim, that he could not see; <sup>3</sup> And ere the lamp of God went out in the temple of

the LORD, where the ark of God was, and Samuel was laid down to sleep; <sup>4</sup> That the LORD called Samuel: and he answered, Here am I. <sup>5</sup> And he ran unto Eli, and said, Here am I; for thou calledst me. And he said, I called not; lie down again. And he went and lay down. <sup>6</sup> And the LORD called yet again, Samuel. And Samuel arose and went to Eli, and said, Here am I; for thou didst call me. And he answered, I called not, my son; lie down again. <sup>7</sup> Now Samuel did not yet know the LORD, neither was the word of the LORD yet revealed unto him. <sup>8</sup> And the LORD called Samuel again the third time. And he arose and went to Eli, and said, Here am I; for thou didst call me. And Eli perceived that the LORD had called the child. <sup>9</sup> Therefore Eli said unto Samuel, Go, lie down: and it shall be, if he call thee, that thou shalt say, Speak, LORD; for thy servant heareth. So Samuel went and lay down in his place. <sup>10</sup> And the LORD came, and stood, and called as at other times, Samuel, Samuel. Then Samuel answered, Speak; for thy servant heareth. <sup>19</sup> And Samuel grew, and the LORD was with him, and did let none of his words fall to the ground.

1 Corinthians 6:12-20

**A**LL THINGS ARE LAWFUL unto me, but all things are not expedient: all things are lawful for me, but I will not be brought under the power of any. <sup>13</sup> Meats for the belly, and the belly for meats: but God shall destroy both it and them. Now the body is not for fornication, but for the Lord; and the Lord for the body. <sup>14</sup> And God hath both raised up the Lord, and will also raise up us by his own power. <sup>15</sup> Know ye not that your bodies are the members of Christ? shall I then take the members of Christ, and make them the members of an harlot? God forbid. <sup>16</sup> What? know ye not that he which is joined to an harlot is one body? for two, saith he, shall be one flesh. <sup>17</sup> But he that is joined unto the Lord is one spirit. <sup>18</sup> Flee fornication.
